

Concert In The Country: Vendor Agreement

BENEFITTING BOOTS FOR TROOPS SATURDAY, OCTOBER 21ST, 2023

The Concert In The Country is a 8th annual event that is held at a private farm in Magnolia, Texas. **This is a rain or shine event.** There will be no refunds due to inclement weather. All vendor spaces are outside spaces.

- 1. The Event committee will evaluate each booth and reserves the right to deny space or individual items in a space that are not of the highest quality. Any vendor found in violation of the following rules may be removed from the event facility.
- 2. To be complete, this entry must be filled out in its entirety and be accompanied by payment for the full booth fee and at least 2 photos showing an example of the merchandise to be sold. Payment is accepted in the form of cash, check or money order. Vendors not accepted will receive a full refund of the booth space fee.
- 3. Deadline for completion of all applications is Friday, OCTOBER 4TH, 2023.
- 4. Vendors needing electricity will be charged an additional \$25.00. Please send the application along with payment to Boots For Troops, c/o Lindsey Rogers, 994 Village Square Dr Condo H Tomball, TX 77375.
- 5. Approximately one week before the event, vendors will receive parking instructions and all other information regarding set-up. Upon arrival, vendors will receive their vendor passes and booth assignments. Booth spaces are first come first serve depending on size of set up.
- 6. Vendors must provide their own table, tent, background materials and all other items needed to make an attractive booth display. Vendors using electrical hookups will need to provide at least a 100 ft. extension cord.
- 7. Vendor hours are: Saturday, October 21ST, 2023 from 1:30pm 11:00pm. Set up by 1:00pm. Paid vendors not set up by the required set up time will lose their space with NO REFUNDS. <u>For safety reasons, all</u> vehicles must be out of the Concert area 1 hour and 30 minutes prior to the gates opening.
- 8. VENDORS MUST BE PRESENT AND SET UP DURING ALL HOURS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC. All vehicles should be removed from the vendor area immediately after unloading, prior to the display setup.
- 9. Vendors and visitors to the concert will assume all risk of accident and injury. Neither Show Sports Farm nor anyone associated with "Boots For Troops" will be held responsible.
- 10. The collection and payment of any and all sales tax is the sole responsibility of the vendor. The concert assumes no responsibility regarding the collection, reporting and/or remittance of sales tax for sales by vendors.
- 11. Each vendor is responsible for his or her own insurance.
