Boots For Troops Concert in the Country BBQ Cook Off Rules & Regulations

GENERAL

- Cut off for registration is October 5th, 2023, or when spots are filled, whichever comes first. All entries must be paid by October 5th, 2023. If you register and do not pay but cut off date, your spot will go to the next person on the waiting list.
- <u>All sites will be 30x30.</u> When registering please let us know if you have an RV, camper, or large cook trailer. All RV's, campers and cook trailers must fit in your 30x30 spot.
- All teams will get 6 GA tickets and 1 parking pass per day (Fri & Sat).
- 10 cases of any brand of beer will be allowed to be brought in. Anything additional will need to be purchased from us and our beer vendor, Silver Eagle. Prepurchase form will be sent out via email.
- Everyone in the cook off area must have a purchased ticket/wristband. Friday entry is free. Parking is \$10. You can purchase discounted tickets up until Friday at cook off meeting.
- Anyone visiting on Saturday MUST have a ticket/wristband. If they purchase tickets on Saturday, they will have to pay the full price of \$40 for general admission.
- Each team is allowed ONE vehicle to park in the competition area, all others will need to pay for parking and park in the designated parking area of the concert.
- No vehicles or trailers will be allowed to leave after 5pm on Friday until Saturday morning. This
 means NO driving in and out of the cook off area Friday night. It is too much of a liability and will not
 be allowed. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Team equipment and decorations must fit within the area assigned.
- BFT will only supply cooking teams with space; all other equipment will need to be supplied by cooking teams. All cooking teams must have a fire extinguisher. Electricity and water will not be supplied.
- Fire holes or open pits are not permitted.
- Propane heaters are permitted for heating purposes but will be used at the discretion and
 responsibility of the team. Pit fires must be wood or wood substance(charcoal). BBQ pits may have gas
 or electricity for start only.
- Quiet time is 11:00pm. This is a BBQ cook off, not battle of the AMPS, this is also on private property. Please turn off the music or turn the music down to your area at 11:00pm and remember this is a family event, so be mindful of your music choices.
- **Main gates to the concert grounds are shut at 11:30pm on Friday night and will re-open again on Saturday at 6:00am. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Excessive use of alcohol can be grounds for disqualification and immediate removal from property. Under NO circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be served to minors.
- Each team is responsible for cleaning up their area. There will be a garbage dumpster in the cook off area. You will be responsible for discarding your trash in the dumpster. DO NOT leave trash dumped in your spot when the event is over, you will not be allowed to return.
- All vehicles, trailers, RV's etc. must be removed and your area must be cleaned up by Noon on Sunday.
- ALL pets must be on a leash and kept in the cook off area ONLY.
- ALL children must always be supervised by an adult. If any children or adults for that matter are found roaming the back of the property or in an area not designated for the event, there may be grounds for disqualification and immediate removal. This is a private property, and the owners will not tolerate trespassing or be liable for any injury or death by ignoring this rule.

COOKING AND JUDGING

- Each team must have a head cook and team members can only cook on one team.
- The head cook must abend the cook off meeting. The head cook is responsible for the operation of the team space and all actions within the designated space by members of their guests.
- The head cook must be onsite and available to the BFT BBQ Committee if necessary.
- All entries will be cooked onsite. The preparation and completion of all meats and opens must be done
 within the confines of the cook off site and during the time limits designated by BFT.
 Once your team and meats arrive at the event the meats are not allowed to be removed from the
 competition grounds.
- Turn ins will consist of 1 fully jointed chicken half, 8 ribs, 8 slices of brisket, 1 full cup of margarita, and 1 large serving of dessert.
